OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the League1 St. Albert Women's Team Head Coach is to lead one of the flagship programs (men's and women's) of the club. It is to utilize players from the High Performance Youth Programming the club has invested heavily in, and to play a critical role in creating a positive and sustaining capstone to our program. This position will be responsible for working with the Club Technical Director to establish a robust Coach Mentorship Program and ensure the pathway is open for St. Albert Impact athletes.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Building a roster of talented players to include, scouting, evaluating and meeting with players, coaches with a focus on players already within the club and the St. Albert region;
- Create and implement a season plan with a clear vision on playing philosophy, individual player development, and game to game planning;
- Conduct and supervise all practices (4 per week);
- Schedule and attend all contests as approved by the Technical Director; must travel with the team unless alternate arrangements have been approved in advance by the Executive Director;
- Attend all scheduled coaching staff meetings;
- Appropriately manage the soccer team's budget including expenses related to team travel, match officials (when applicable), and team equipment;
- Provide weekly updates of program to Technical Director;
- Assist in the implementation and delivery of a Coach Mentorship Program that will link to the established club coaching philosophy;
- Committed to the personal development of each player on the roster; developing a competitive environment, ensuring our players are engaged in ethical behavior and good sportsmanship, and assist in the development of leadership skills;

REQUIREMENTS:

- Canada Soccer National B Licence with an intention to have a Canadian A Licence by April 2026
- First-Aid Certification
- Vulnerable Sector Screening
- Making Ethical Decisions and Respect in Sport
- Strong communication skills – written and spoken English;
- Strong player developer with a history of training high performance athletes aged 17-23
